Police Incident Report Summary January 8 – January 14, 2024

- January 8, 2024 A complaint came in of harassment at the PADS shelter at Holy Family. An officer responded and spoke to both parties resolving the issue.
- January 9, 2024 There were reports of numerous vehicles stuck on the side of the road or in the ditch. Officers responded to all and assisted as needed.
- January 9, 2024 A resident reported hearing a suspicious noise outside of their house late in the evening. Officers investigated and it appears that it was a cat scratching on the side of the home.
- January 10, 2024 A resident's vehicle was stolen from Schaumburg and with the assistance of our Investigator was able to locate the car in Chicago. The vehicle was ultimately recovered by CPD and returned to the suburbs.
- January 11, 2024Two suspicious persons were reported walking down the roadway on Dewey at
Palatine. The area was searched and the pair was not located.
- January 11, 2024 A silver Toyota was reported to be speeding through the neighborhoods in the 200 block of Florence. The area was checked and the car was not found. Officers spoke to a few neighbors who did not see anything.
- January 12, 2024 A tree was reported down on Palatine and Dewey. Officers, with the assistance of Palatine Police, were able to remove the tree to the side of the road.
- January 13, 2024 Another tree was reported to be hanging over the road near the 300 block of Roberts. The responding officer was able to saw back the tree and clear the hazard.
- January 13, 2024 A suspicious person was reported in the 2100 block of Greenock Street. Officers responded and were unable to locate any persons.

January 14, 2024 A suspicious vehicle was called in in the 200 block of Poteet. A white or silver Acura was sitting in the middle of the roadway according to the caller. Officers responded and found the car to be parked correctly.

January 14, 2024 Inverness officers responded to a burglary in the 600 block of Braeburn Road. The residents returned home to find the garage door and entry door to the house open. Officers checked the house upon arrival finding no one inside. Entry was most likely made by forcing open a side door after the offenders attempted to remove the electrical service meter outside. Once inside they ransacked the home removing numerous items before leaving. The matter is under investigation.
