Police Incident Report Summary January 29 – February 4, 2024

January 30, 2024	A resident reported that an unknown individual attempted to gain access to her checking account at BMO Harris. The bank noticed the activity and advised the potential victim. A report was completed, and no loss was suffered.
January 30, 2024	Near Haman Road and Florence Avenue a suspicious vehicle was reported and the driver reportedly dumped the contents of his ashtray on the ground. An officer responded and did not find the car or any evidence that refuse was deposited on the ground.
February 1, 2024	Inverness Officers assisted Palatine with a subject who was walking in and out of traffic near Quentin and Palatine. The subject was suffering from drug related issues and was turned over to the paramedics for medical assistance.
February 1, 2024	Several vehicles were reported to be driving recklessly and doing "donuts" in the Holy Family parking lot. Several vehicles left the area as officers arrived on scene.
February 2, 2024	A suspicious vehicle was reported in the 200 block of Roberts Road. The caller returned home to find an unknown vehicle in their driveway. Officers spoke to the occupant and learned that they were doing some work at a neighboring house and had mistakenly parked in the wrong drive.
February 2, 2024	Several youths were reported to be running around the neighborhood in the 1200 block of Barclay Circle. Officers responded to the area and learned that some people from Barrington High School posted on social media about a Nerf Gun event in this area. The subjects who were contacted by police were asked to put the word out that police were in the area and the event was cancelled.
February 2, 2024	Rolling Meadows Police requested assistance in breaking up a large gathering in a parking lot of motor vehicle enthusiasts. Inverness sent one officer to assist in dispersing the trespassers.
February 3, 2024	A resident reported they were the victim of an internet scam involving their crypto currency and investment accounts.
