<u>Police Incident Report Summary</u> <u>February 12 – February 18, 2024</u>

February 12, 2024	An animal complaint about dogs running loose in the 2000 block of Abbotsford Drive was reported. The owner of the dogs was spoken to, and he agreed to restrict the boundaries of the dogs and to better watch their behavior while outside.
February 14, 2024	A woman reported to police that she was bitten by a cat in the 1800 block of Ashbury. An officer completed the required paperwork to report an animal bite to the county.
February 15, 2024	A fraud was reported in the 300 block of Highland Road. An unknown subject appears to have stolen a check from the postal service and altered it for their gain. This case is being investigated by our department and the postal service.
February 16, 2024	A suspicious noise was reported in the 600 block of Balmoral Lane. The resident said they heard a loud bang outside their house in the late evening hours. Officers responded to check the house and the neighborhood. They were unable to find the source of the noise.
February 17, 2024	Inverness Officers helped Barrington Hills Police and South Barrington Police as they blocked traffic for them at Palatine Road and Barrington Road. A short while later they finished their investigation, and the road was opened.
February 17, 2024	A suspicious incident was reported in the 1600 block of Dublin Court. Unwanted individuals were found to be on the property. A report was completed and there is follow-up work occurring.
