<u>Police Incident Report Summary</u> <u>February 26 – March 3, 2024</u>

February 27, 2024	Officers were kept busy clearing the roadways that were blocked from fallen trees and limbs due to the tornado that went through the village. Baldwin Road, Roselle Road, Freeman Road, Durham Drive, Ela Road, St. Andrews Lane and Aberdeen were among the many roadways that had debris strewn about that officers diligently cleared through the night.
February 27, 2024	A report was taken in the 500 block of Aberdeen due to a tree limb falling on a parked vehicle.
February 27, 2024	An accident report was completed when a tree limb fell onto a vehicle in the roadway at Ela Road and Palatine Road.
February 27, 2024	A soliciting complaint was called in for the 300 block of Inverway Road. A subject in a black pickup truck reportedly knocked on the complainant's door asking if they needed work done due to the storm. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate this individual.
February 28, 2024	Officers and firefighters were called to the 0-100 block of Dewey Road for a downed power line in the yard. Com Ed responded as well to handle the matter.
February 28, 2024	Landscapers working in the 1600 block of Appleby Road knocked on the doors of some homes to solicit work from the storm. They were advised to cease that activity.
February 28, 2024	An elderly resident in the 0-100 block of Inverway Road reported that her garage door was not working due to a power loss and she needed to leave the home for medical treatment. An Inverness officer responded and assisted in opening the door and later securing it for the her so she could tend to her matters.
February 29, 2024	Officers, along with Inverness Fire, blocked off Roselle Road between Baldwin and Palatine due to an energized downed power line that was causing a fire on the side of the road. Com Ed responded and about 2 ½ hours later the roadway was safe and reopened.

March 1, 2024

Officers and fire personnel responded again to Roselle Road near Aberdeen for a downed tree branch on a power line. The road was closed for 2 hours while crews tended to the issue.

March 3, 2024

A suspicious subject was reportedly walking in the 1400 block of Shire Circle. Offices checked the area and were unable to locate the individual.
