Police Incident Report Summary

March 11, 2024- March 17, 2024

March 11, 2024	An Inverness Officer found a power line down that caused a small fire in the area of Palatine Road and Barrington Road. Hoffman Estates Fire came out and extinguished the fire.
March 12, 2024	A suspicious person was walking near Ela Road and Palatine Road without a shirt carrying Jewel bags. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the subject.
March 12, 2024	A vehicle struck a mailbox in the 2000 block of Abbotsford Drive. The responding officer completed a report and delivered a temporary mailbox from the PD for the victim in this matter.
March 13, 2024	Officers responded to a 3-car accident at Palatine Road and Dewey Road. One driver was transported to the hospital for minor injuries.
March 13, 2024	A resident in the 400 block of Roselle Road called in a suspicious blinking light in their neighbor's garage. An officer responded and discovered that the owner had left their hazard lights flashing on their parked vehicle.
March 16, 2024	A bad boiler with an exposed flame prompted a fire and police response to Inverness Health and Rehab on Colonial Parkway. Personnel on scene made sure there was no present danger and turned things over to maintenance.
March 16, 2024	Subjects were observed acting disorderly outside their vehicle in the 400 block of Cumnock. Officers arrived to check, however, the vehicle and its occupants had already left the area.
March 17, 2024	Two women were out driving in the neighborhoods near the 700 block of Thompsons Way pulling in and out of driveways. Officers located the car and spoke to the women. They were found to be Jehovah's witnesses inviting residents to an event at Harper College.
