Police Incident Report Summary

March 18, 2024- March 24, 2024

March 18, 2024	Inverness Officers were requested by IDOT (Illinois Department of Transportation) crew members to block Dundee Road as a wire came down onto the roadway. The line was a cable line and not energized, therefore it was quickly removed, and the lanes opened back up for traffic.
March 20, 2024	A suspicious vehicle was called in near Skyle Lane and Abbotsford Drive. The dark colored car was driving slowly through the neighborhood and stopped at times on the side of the road. The vehicle was gone when officers arrived but ascertained the owner via the Flock camera system and determined there was no nefarious activity afoot.
March 21, 2024	A solicitor complaint was made on a subject going door to door for roofing without a permit on Whispering Pines Court. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate him.
March 21, 2024	A resident in the 300 block of Poteet Avenue reported that sometime over the winter unknown person(s) entered the unlocked shed and removed bikes and lawn equipment.
March 21, 2024	Several bags of rocks were taken from the driveway of a residence on Scots Court. The rocks were valued at \$30.
March 23, 2024	Officers responded to a suspicious person in the 1600 block of Galloway Drive. The caller reported that someone may have been looking into a window via the camera system. Officers checked the residence and learned there may have been shadows giving off different appearances, therefore no criminal activity was happening.
March 23, 2024	A report of individuals moving items out of a house for sale on Braeburn Road came in late in the evening. Officers went to the house and did not find anyone there and determined that the house was secure after checking the perimeter.
