Police Incident Report Summary

March 25, 2024– March 31, 2024

- March 25, 2024 Officers responded to the 1800 Block of Ashbury Court to conduct an investigation into a stolen auto. Through the investigation and subsequent video footage it appears unknown subjects arrive in a stolen auto and pull car door handles until they locate an unlocked car. Once inside that car they used the garage door remote to access the interior where a BMW was found unlocked with the key fob. The offenders removed the BMW and were last seen Southbound Barrington Road. The vehicle was located in the 8000 Block of South Yates in Chicago and returned to the owner.
- March 27, 2024 Inverness Police assisted the Inverness Fire Department for a report of smoke in the building at 1800 Colonial Parkway. The HVAC system was having an issue and officers helped as fire personnel located the bad belt and began to clear the smoke.
- March 28, 2024 A Groot truck became entangled in some low telecommunication lines in the 1800 Block of Thornhill Road. Police and Fire responded and assisted in freeing the garbage truck from the lines.
- March 29, 2024 A passerby reported seeing a backpack and other items lying on the ground near Ela Road and Banbury Road. The caller stated an unknown subject stopped and retrieved the items before parking on the side of the road. An officer responded and the vehicle was gone but learned that the vehicle was being driven by a good Samaritan that picked up the items and returned them to the owner in Palatine.
- March 30, 2024 Officers responded to a two car crash with injuries in the early morning hours at Dundee Road and Glencrest Drive. Both drivers were transported to the hospital with minor injuries.
- March 30, 2024 A suspicious vehicle was called in for the 700 Block of Thompsons Way. The green vehicle was parked with its hazards on for a brief period of time before leaving the area. Officers were unable to locate the car after checking the area.
