Police Incident Report Summary

April 22, 2024– April 28, 2024

- April 22, 2024 Residents in the 1600 block of Dunbar Road reported mail stolen from their mailbox. A report was completed, however, there is no offender information available.
- April 24, 2024 A suspicious person was reported in the 1400 block of Turkey Trail. An unknown person came to the residence to complete a Facebook Marketplace sale. Due to the resident becoming nervous about the sale officers arrived and put the resident at ease.
- April 24, 2024 A theft of mail from the mailbox was reported in the 400 block of Inverway. This matter, and other similar cases, are being followed up by investigations and the US Postal Service.
- April 25, 2024 While on patrol officers located an open door to a building in the 100 block of Roselle Road. Officers checked the premises and found the door had been left open on accident.
- April 25, 2024 A dog was reported to be running loose in the 1700 block of Kitson Circle. The dog was able to get past the invisible fence. The owner was located and spoken to.
- April 25, 2024 Solicitors were reported in the 0-100 block of Firth Road. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate them.
- April 27, 2024 A young child was reported to be walking alone in the 500 block of Saint Andrews Lane wearing only pajamas. An Inverness officer responded to the area, and with the help of a citizen, located the child in a rear yard fenced in pool. The child ended up entering the pool and immediately began struggling. The officer and citizen worked together to rescue the child and pull him to safety. The Fire Department responded to check on the child and the parents were located. The child had managed to leave the house without the parents' knowledge.
